1 On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 33, insert:

12 **beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses**
13 **from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts**
14 **and Medicare receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost**
15 **recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries**
16 **and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds**
17 **and federal funds not described in section 2 (9), chapter _____, Oregon**
18 **Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the De-**
19 **partment of Human Services, for the Oregon Eligibility Partnership,**
20 **is increased by \$1,830,240, for information technology system changes**
21 **required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.**

1 **SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
2 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 3 (8), chapter**
3 **_____, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium**
4 **beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses**
5 **from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2,**
6 **chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected**
7 **or received by the Department of Human Services, for the Oregon El-**
8 **igibility Partnership, is increased by \$313,406, for information technol-**
9 **ogy system changes required to carry out the provisions of this 2023**
10 **Act.**

11 **SECTION 7. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
12 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the**
13 **biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount**
14 **of \$7,843, to support position costs related to system updates required**
15 **to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.**

16 **SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
17 **the amount of \$626,811 is established for the biennium beginning July**
18 **1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
19 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
20 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
21 **Oregon Health Authority, for the Office of Information Services, to**
22 **support position costs related to system updates required to carry of**
23 **the provisions of this 2023 Act.**

24 **SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
25 **the amount of \$7,843 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,**
26 **2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal**
27 **funds collected or received by Oregon Health Authority to support**
28 **position costs related to system updates required to carry out the**
29 **provisions of this 2023 Act.**

30 **SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
