Work Session

- HB 4148 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to expand programs related to wildlife disease.
- HB 4132 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, the State Fish and Wildlife Commission and the Department of State Lands to implement the Ocean Policy Advisory Council recommendations to develop an adaptive management and social monitoring program to support marine reserves.
- HB 4060 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, out of the General Fund, for deposit in the Oregon Agricultural Heritage Fund.

Public Hearing

- HB 4049 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon State University Extension Service and the College of Agricultural Sciences of Oregon State University to study the fate and transport of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) found in biosolids applied to agricultural fields.
- HB 4061 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the State Department of Agriculture to establish an elk damage prevention and compensation pilot program.
- HB 4090
Prohibits the Energy Facility Siting Council from exercising jurisdiction over or requiring a site certificate for an energy facility that is a renewable energy facility or transmission line, is sited wholly within federal lands and is subject to review under the National Environmental Policy Act.
