HB 4145 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Creates the crime of using an animal in a display of animal crushing.

HB 4146  
Provides that a petition for a Family Abuse Prevention Act order, Elderly Persons and Persons with Disabilities Abuse Prevention Act order or sexual abuse restraining order may be filed in the county in which the abuse occurred.

HB 4001 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes the Task Force on Specialty Courts.

HB 4121 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission, in consultation with the State Department of Agriculture, to create a map of locations of premises licensed to produce marijuana or industrial hemp.

HB 4140 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Appropriates moneys to the Department of Justice to fund certain programs that assist victims of crime.

HB 4043  
Creates the crime of interfering with an investigation into an offense against an animal.

HB 4122  
Provides that a person's participation in the Department of State Police's fingerprint retention program authorizes the department to submit the person's fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation's rap back system.
