Public Hearing

SB 1534

Allows a school district, an education service district or a public charter school to employ a person who is not licensed or registered with the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to teach reading to students.

SB 1535

Authorizes district school boards to establish a policy to encourage students to develop vocational skills by performing maintenance tasks for school districts.

SB 1550 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Transfers certain duties, functions and powers related to teaching, administrative and personnel licensure from the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to the Department of Education.

Possible Work Session

SB 1558

Makes an exception to abbreviated school day requirements for when a student voluntarily does not schedule a class for one or more class periods or for certain asynchronous instruction.

SB 1583

Prohibits discrimination when selecting textbooks, instructional materials, program materials or library books that are used in the public schools of this state.
