**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02-14-2024 MEETING: Permits the director of a treatment facility to admit a minor for inpatient substance use disorder diagnosis, evaluation and treatment for up to 14 days with parental consent when the minor objects to the admission.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02-14-2024 MEETING: Authorizes the Department of Human Services to license adult foster homes serving up to seven residents if the home meets specified criteria and pays the appropriate fee.
