SB 1514 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires the Director of the Employment Department to conduct periodic assessments to determine the solvency of the Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Fund.

SB 1515 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Employment Department to collaborate with the Bureau of Labor and Industries to identify statutory changes that are needed to require the department and the bureau to perform certain duties.

SB 1580

Creates the crime of fraudulent misrepresentation by an employer to an insurer of certain employee-related data with the intent to decrease the employer's workers' compensation insurance premium.

Public Hearing

SB 1595 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Increases certain exemptions from garnishment and execution. Modifies provisions relating to unfair debt collection practices. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
