#### Work Session

SB 1548

For the part of the state located in the Pacific Time Zone, abolishes the annual one-hour change in time from standard time to daylight saving time and maintains the Pacific Time Zone portion of Oregon on standard time for all 12 months of the calendar year.

HB 4019

Provides for the date and time of the convening of electors of the President and Vice President of the United States.

HB 4104

Designates the fourth Wednesday in February of each year as Hypertrophic Cardiomyopathy Awareness Day.

HB 4117

Authorizes the Oregon Government Ethics Commission to issue advisory opinions on the application of the public meetings law to actual or hypothetical circumstances.

HB 4119

Enhances the protections for post-secondary institutions of education, student athletes and others regarding the provision of compensation for a student's name, image, likeness or athletic reputation.

HB 4020

Requires an applicant for a commission as a notary public to complete a course of study offered by the Secretary of State before taking the required examination, even if the applicant already holds a commission in Oregon.
