Subject: HB 4153 - Relating to artificial intelligence: Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 4153 relates to artificial intelligence. The introduced version of the measure creates a thirteen (13) member task force to examine and identify terms and definitions related to artificial intelligence that may be used for legislation. The measure directs the task force to seek input from a broad range of stakeholders, including stakeholders from institutions of higher education, consumer advocacy groups and small, medium, and large businesses affected by artificial intelligence policies. House Bill 4153 requires the task force to report its findings and recommendations to the interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to information management and technology on or before December 1, 2024. The measure directs the Legislative Policy and Research Director to provide staff support to the task force and requires all agencies of state government to assist the task force in the performance of its duties.

Finally, the measure sunsets the task force on January 1, 2025, declares an emergency and is effective on passage.

A public hearing on House Bill 4153 was held on February 7, 2024 and materials related to House Bill 4153 are posted on OLIS. The measure does have a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

If adopted, the -1 Amendment would add one voting member from the Oregon Judicial Department and move the Task Force members from the Legislative Assembly from non-voting to voting member status. The composition of the Task Force on Artificial Intelligence within House Bill 4153 would be 14 members total (13 voting and 1 nonvoting).

## **Recommended Changes - Amendment**

LFO recommends adoption of the -1 amendment.
