Bill Title: Relating to fingerprint retention.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of State Police, Statewide

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Department of State Police to participate in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Rap Back system. The measure allows an authorized agency to participate in the state fingerprint retention program. Authorized agencies must subscribe to the Rap Back program and submit an implementation plan, no later than December 31, 2024, to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to judiciary. The specified provisions become operative January 1, 2025, and the measure takes effect on the 91st day after sine die.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
