Bill Title: Relating to services to individuals who are under 21 years of age; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Youth Authority, District Attorneys, Judicial Department, Public Defense Commission, Department of Education, Oregon Health Authority, Department of Human Services, Department of Justice, Department of Corrections, Department of Early Learning and Care

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

As amended, the measure directs the Oregon Health Authority to obtain a federal waiver to provide services and supports for individuals under 21 who qualify for Medicaid- funded assistance and are at risk of institutional placement.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
