Bill Title: Relating to expungements.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure modifies the process for setting aside convictions, dismissals, citations, and guilty except for insanity judgments. The measure requires the Oregon Judicial Department, no later than January 1, 2026, and annually thereafter, to submit a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary, concerning the setting aside of arrests, citations, charges, convictions and contempt of court findings, and judgments of guilty except for insanity.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
