Bill Title: Relating to access to health care; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Health Authority, Department of Consumer and Business Services, Department of Human Services, Department of Justice

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates \$5 million General Fund to establish the virtual opioid dependency program. The measure establishes requirements for a parent or guardian to admit a minor to a treatment facility if the minor does not agree. Inpatient care for minors habitually using cannabis and at risk for using other controlled substances must be covered by health benefit plans. The measure directs the Oregon Health Authority to establish an advisory committee on reciprocal emergency medical services licensing and requires the Health Licensing Office to manage reciprocal emergency medical services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
