

Educators Survey NEEDS FOR BEHAVIORAL SUPPORT




Our Survey

- -100% of Staff Members Experienced an Injury with Lasting Effect or Required Medical Attention
- -100% Reported an Increase in Violent or Aggressive
- -76% Stated These Behaviors and Inadequate **Support Negatively Impacted Their Desire to**
- -100% Reported Difficulties in Seeking Mental and **Behavioral Health Supports for their Students**



Capacity CHALLENGES IN BEHAVIORAL SUPPORT



Every workforce needs the proper tools.

They also need the capacity to utilize those tools.

- -Students: Trauma, Increased Needs, Become Disengaged
- -Teachers: Become overwhelmed, experiencing stress, burnout, and reduced effectiveness, ultimately they leave or do not enter the field.
- -Learning Environment: Suffers as individual needs aren't met, impacting everyone's -progress and well-being.
- -Overall Growth: Both students and teachers face limitations in reaching their potential. This lost potential continues into elementary school and beyond



Investments Now

ENSURING COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT FOR ALL STUDENTS WELL-BEING



Unsustainable solution: Additional coaching and professional development can be helpful.

Unsustainable solution: Continued inadequate early childhood mental & behavioral health



We need to increase classroom staffing to ensure effective delivery of those resources.

Action is needed to address this critical gap and not by early childhood educators.
