Subject: HB 4151-A4 – Relating to youth behavioral health.

Work Session Recommendations

HB 4151 directs the System of Care Advisory Council, budgeted within the Oregon Health Authority, to establish a subcommittee on the youth behavioral health workforce. The subcommittee is required to examine the current behavioral health workforce structure and identify methods to expand the behavioral health workforce. The subcommittee will submit a report, including policy recommendations, to the interim behavioral health committees by September 15, 2024. The measure declares an emergency and is effective on passage and is repealed on December 31, 2025.

The -A4 adds \$196,253 General Fund. Costs include reimbursements to eligible committee members, hosting and facilitating the meetings, as well as interpretation and translation services.

Recommended Changes
