Subject: HB 5201 – Bond Authorization Work Session Recommendations

HB 5201 amends the limits established during the 2023 legislative session for the maximum amount of bonds that state agencies may issue. The proceeds from the issuance of bonds are included as revenues in agency budgets.

The -2 amendment replaces the bill and includes the following increases in general obligation and lottery revenue bonds authorized to be issued during the 2023-25 biennium:

- \$12.1 million of Article XI-Q bonds to finance one new and three ongoing projects for Oregon Youth Authority.
- \$8.1 million of Article XI-Q and Article XI-F bonds to finance two public university capital projects.
- \$15.2 million of additional Article XI-Q bonds for the Clackamas County courthouse replacement project.
- \$7 million of additional Article XI-Q bonds for the Benton County courthouse replacement project.
- \$5.1 million of Article XI-Q bonds for the Department of Emergency Management's Statewide Preparedness Incident Response Equipment (SPIRE) grant program.
- \$37.2 million of lottery revenue bonds to support five projects.

Lottery revenue bond authority is also reduced by \$10 million to reflect the repeal of two projects that will now be financed through a General Fund appropriation in SB 5701.

A summary of general obligation and lottery bond funded projects included in the -2 amendment is attached. Bonds are scheduled to be sold in the spring of 2025, so no debt service payments are due in the 2023-25 biennium. Debt service on the additional bonding is estimated to be \$9.5 million General Fund and \$6.2 million Lottery Funds in the 2025-27 biennium. As amended, HB 5201 modifies the scope of multiple general obligation and lottery bond projects authorized in prior legislative sessions.

Recommended Changes
