Subject: SB 1501 – Program Change

Work Session Recommendations

SB 1501 relates to state financial administration. The -2 amendment replaces the bill. The amended version is referred to as the "Program Change" bill. The measure has an emergency clause and is effective upon passage. The measure, as amended, implements the statutory changes necessary to support the 2023-25 legislatively approved budget and to clarify the application of statutes. The bill is not an appropriation bill and therefore does not include the appropriation of funds.

Law changes in the measure include, expanding allowable uses of the Long-Term Rental Assistance Fund, establishing the Private Security Entity Account, clarifying recipients of two grants, extending the sunset of the Tide Gate Grant and Loan Fund, repealing the transfer of \$40 million to the General Fund and increasing the transfer of Public Employee Benefit Board revenues to the DAS Insurance Fund to \$90 million.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -2 amendment.
