

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4086 Relating to children

HB 4086 requires the Department of Human Services to commission two studies: one on the scope of child abuse investigations in Oregon, and the other on a response to children exhibiting problematic sexual behavior.

Both studies require a facilitator who specializes in public policy and require preliminary and final reports to interim legislative committees. DHS is also required to establish an advisory committee for each study to assist the facilitators in their research and presentation.

In 2023-25, the estimated cost is \$230,946 General Fund and \$77,640 Federal Funds. This covers the cost of the studies and reimbursable expenses of the advisory committees.

The -A5 amendment adds funding to the bill.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 4086 be amended by the –A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
