VICTIMS' RIGHTS PACKAGE HB 4146

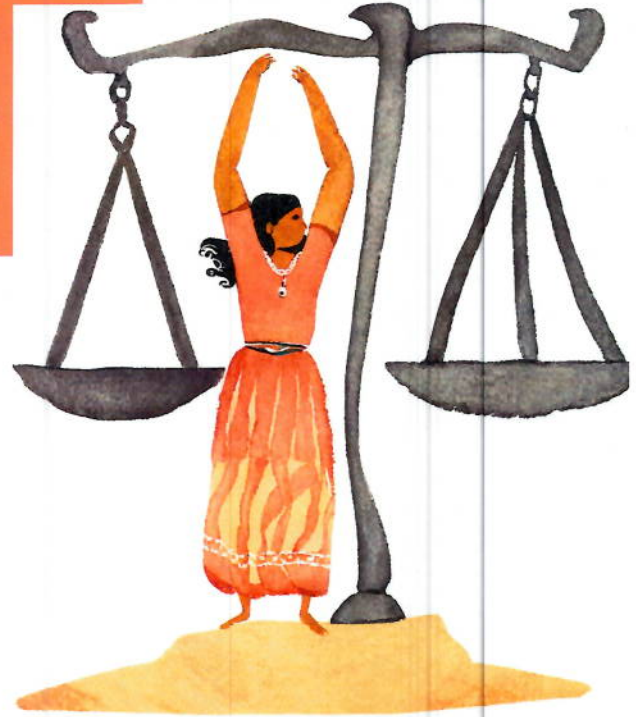
Closing loopholes and increasing victims' access to justice in two ways:

REVENGE PORN FIX

Oregon statute requires that **victims** of revenge porn be **"identifiable"** in the explicit photos shared of them.

This has led to instances where courts **cannot convict perpetrators** because the victims were not identifiable solely through the photo, even if they could be through additional relevant evidence.

This package **removes the word "identifiable"** from the statute, effectively **closing this loophole**.



RESTRAINING ORDER EXPANSION

Domestic and sexual violence survivors can currently file for restraining orders in the counties **where they or their abusers reside**.

This package **expands these options** to also allow survivors to file for **where the abuse occurred**, an option currently only available to victims of stalking.
