## **SUMMARY**

Digest: The Act tells a state agency to study the shortage of MEs in this state. The Act tells the agency to provide the results of the study to the legislature by October 1, 2024. The Act goes into effect when the Governor signs it. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.0).

<i>Digest: The Act makes a state agency study the shortage of medical examiners in this state. The Act makes the agency provide the results of the study to the legislature by May 1, 2025. The Act takes effect on the 91st day after sine die. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2).</i>

Directs the Department of State Police to study the causes of and ways to address the medical examiner shortage, and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than <i>May 1, 2025</i>
) October 1, 2024.

Sunsets on January 2, <i>2026</i>Ù 2025.

<i>Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.</i>
