SUMMARY

Digest: The Act makes a small group to look at the youth behavioral workforce. (Flesch Readability Score: 77.8).

<i>Digest: Makes a task force about youth behavioral health. Starts soon. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.8).</i>

<i>Establishes the Task Force on Youth Behavioral Health Workforce. Directs the task force to identify strategies to increase access to and the diversity of Oregon's youth-serving behavioral health workforce. Requires the task force to submit a report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to behavioral health not later than September 15, 2024.</i>

Directs the System of Care Advisory Council to establish a subcommittee on the youth behavioral health workforce. Requires the subcommittee to submit an initial report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to behavioral health not later than September 15, 2024, and a final report to the Legislative Assembly not later than December 15, 2025.

Sunsets December 31, 2025.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.
