SUMMARY

Digest: The Act keeps limits on producing canola in certain areas. The Act makes certain changes to the limits. The Act goes into effect when the Governor signs it. (Flesch Readability Score: 70.4).

<i>Digest: The Act tells a state agency to study issues around a genus of plants in the cabbage and mustard family in an area south of Salem. The Act tells the state agency to report on the results of the study. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.1).</i>

<i>Directs the State Department of Agriculture to study issues relating to brassica production in the Willamette Valley Protected District and report on the results to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2025.</i>

Extends the sunset on provisions relating to limits on Willamette Valley Protected District canola production to January 2, 2028. Changes the definition of "canola." Provides that isolation distances must equal or exceed customary isolation distances.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.
