**Summary of Revenue Changes**

Senate Bill 1531 appropriates \$250,000 General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services to be transferred to the Oregon Historical Society to work with national, regional, state, local, and tribal organizations, and other public or private entities to plan and support the observance of the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the United States.

**Summary of Committee Action**

Senate Bill 1531 creates the 27-member America 250 Oregon Commission charged with coordinating and providing guidance for Oregon’s official observance of the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the United States, as marked by the Declaration of Independence in 1776. In addition to coordination and planning, the Commission may engage in and encourage fundraising efforts. The bill directs the Oregon Historical Society to provide staff support to the Commission and specifies that voting members of the Commission are entitled to compensation and expenses.

The measure appropriates \$250,000 General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services to be transferred to the Oregon Historical Society to support the Commission. If the funding provided is insufficient or if the Commission is not successful in fundraising efforts, additional state funding may be requested during the 2025-27 biennium to support the Commissions work through July 4, 2026.
