WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure establishes the following deadlines for presession-filed legislative measures for the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly:

- 1) Members and committees must submit drafting requests to Legislative Counsel no later than 5 p.m. on September 27, 2024;
- 2) Legislative Counsel must deliver drafts to requesters no later than 5 p.m. on December 4, 2024; and
- 3) Requesters shall submit drafts to be presession filed to the Senate or House desk no later than 5 p.m. on December 13, 2024.

It exempts the President of the Senate, the House Interim Committee on Rules, and the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means from the deadlines.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Following the passage of Measure 71 in 2010, the Legislative Assembly now meets annually; a long-session in odd-numbered years and a short-session in even-numbered years. As a result of the change to annual sessions, the chambers initiated the practice, in 2011, of introducing a concurrent resolution, in conjunction with the sine die resolution, to establish limitations and timelines for the long and short session.
