SUMMARY

Digest: The Act makes changes to crimes related to stalking. The Act also changes the definitions for stalking laws. The Act takes effect on July 1, 2024. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Modifies definitions pertaining to stalking orders and stalking offenses. <i>Increases penalties for</i>Ù Expands the circumstances in which the crimes of stalking and violating a court's stalking protective order <i>in certain circumstances</i>Ù constitute a felony offense. <i>Punishes by a maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.</i>Ù

Takes effect July 1, 2024.
