House Bill 4012

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act does not allow an insurer to make a person enrolled in a health benefit plan go to a certain pharmacy in some circumstances for certain types of drugs. The Act also applies to other types of entities that pay for health care. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.2). Prohibits issuers of health benefit plans, health care service contractors or multiple employer welfare arrangements from requiring that drugs that are administered by a health care provider be

dispensed at a certain pharmacy or by a pharmacy that is in the provider's network, under specified circumstances.

5	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2024 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.

7	(a) "Administer" means to directly apply a drug to the body of a patient by injection,
8	inhalation, ingestion or any other means.
9	(b) "Clinician-administered drug" means an outpatient prescription drug other than a
10	vaccine, a drug administered through a clinic affiliated with a hospital or a drug adminis-
11	tered in a hospital outpatient infusion center, that:
12	(A) Cannot reasonably be:
13	(i) Administered by a patient for whom the drug is prescribed; or
14	(ii) Administered by an individual other than a health care provider who is assisting the
15	patient with the self-administration of the drug; and
16	(B) Is typically administered in the office of a physician or other health care provider
17	authorized by law to administer the drug.
18	(c) "Health benefit plan" has the meaning given that term in ORS 743B.005.
19	(d) "Health care provider" means an individual who is licensed, certified or otherwise
20	authorized to provide health care services in this state.
21	(2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, a health benefit plan that reimburses the cost
22	of hospital or medical expenses may not, for an enrollee with a chronic, complex, rare or
23	life-threatening medical condition:
24	(a) Require a covered clinician-administered drug to be dispensed only by certain phar-
25	macies or only by pharmacies participating in the health benefit plan issuer's provider net-
