On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2	"SECTION 1. ORS 188.120 is amended to read:
3	"188.120. (1) If a vacancy in election or office of Representative in Congress or United States
4	Senator occurs before the 61st day before the general election, the Governor shall call a specia
5	election to fill that vacancy. If a vacancy in election or office of United States Senator occurs after
6	the 62nd day before the general election but on or before the general election, and if the term of
7	that office is not regularly filled at that election, the Governor shall call a special election to fil
8	the vacancy [as soon as practicable after the general election], with the special election occurring
9	at least 80 days and not more than 150 days after the vacancy occurred.
10	"(2) If a special election to fill the vacancy in election or office of Representative in Congress
11	[or United States Senator] is called before the 80th day after the vacancy occurs, each major political
12	party shall select its nominee for the office and certify the name of the nominee to the Secretary
13	of State. The Secretary of State shall place the name of the nominee on the ballot.
14	"(3) If a special election to fill the vacancy in election or office of Representative in Congress
15	or United States Senator is called after the 79th day after the vacancy occurs, a special primary
16	election shall be conducted by the Secretary of State for the purpose of nominating a candidate o
17	each major political party. A declaration of candidacy or nominating petition may be filed not later
18	than the 10th day following the issuance of the writ of election.
19	"(4)(a) For a vacancy in election or office of United States Senator, the Governor shall
20	fill the vacancy by appointment. The Governor shall make the appointment required under
21	this subsection no later than 30 days after the vacancy occurs.
22	"(b) A person appointed under this subsection must:
23	"(A) Be a citizen qualified to hold the office; and
24	"(B) For at least 180 days before the date on which the vacancy occurred, be affiliated
25	with the same political party as the person who vacated the office of United States Senator
26	"(c) The political affiliation of a person appointed under this subsection shall be deter
27	mined in accordance with ORS 236.100.
28	"(d) An appointment made under this subsection shall expire when the term of office
29	ends or a successor to the office is elected and qualified under this section, whichever occurs
30	first.".
