

# House Bill 4033

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue for Representative Nancy Nathanson)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act extends the assessment on nursing homes for six years. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.3).

Extends the long term care assessment from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2032.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 23, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003, as amended by section 8, chapter 757,  
5 Oregon Laws 2005, section 11, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2007, section 19, chapter 608, Oregon Laws  
6 2013, and section 2, chapter 66, Oregon Laws 2018, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 23.** [*Sections 15 to 22, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003,*] **ORS 409.800 to 409.816 and 409.900**  
8 apply to long term care facility assessments imposed in calendar quarters beginning on or after  
9 November 26, 2003, and before [*July 1, 2026*] **June 30, 2032.**

10 **SECTION 2.** Section 31, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003, as amended by section 9, chapter 757,  
11 Oregon Laws 2005, section 14, chapter 780, Oregon Laws 2007, section 49, chapter 11, Oregon Laws  
12 2009, section 21, chapter 608, Oregon Laws 2013, and section 3, chapter 66, Oregon Laws 2018, is  
13 amended to read:

14 **Sec. 31.** [*Sections 15 to 22, 24 and 29, chapter 736, Oregon Laws 2003,*] **ORS 409.800 to 409.816**  
15 **and 409.900** are repealed on January 2, [2028] **2034.**
