

House Bill 4073

Sponsored by Representatives MCINTIRE, SCHARF, Senator SMITH DB, Representative LEWIS; Representatives LEVY B, MANNIX, Senators KNOPP, LINTHICUM (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Gives more money to the Department of Justice to fund workers for the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. (Flesch Reading Score: 62.8).

Increases the biennial appropriation to the Department of Justice for the purpose of funding positions for the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
5 **made to the Criminal Justice Division of the Department of Justice by section 1 (3), chapter**
6 **382, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, is increased by \$2,416,495 for**
7 **the purpose of funding positions to support the Internet Crimes Against Children Task**
8 **Force.**
