

# House Bill 4123

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Judiciary for Representative Jason Kropf)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the DOJ to give to the Sexual Assault Task Force for SANE certification. (Flesch Readability Score: 71.0).

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Justice to fund the management of the Oregon SAE/SANE Certification Commission by the Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force.

2 Relating to the Sexual Assault Task Force.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of the General**  
6 **Fund, the amount of \$400,000, for distribution to the Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task**  
7 **Force for purposes of managing the Oregon SAE/SANE Certification Commission, including**  
8 **outreach, training, technical assistance, establishing competencies and standards, member-**  
9 **ship oversight and multidisciplinary work with entities including law enforcement agencies,**  
10 **hospitals and community-based victim services organizations.**
