

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4140

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) Each biennium, the Department of Justice shall include in its agency**  
3 **request budget filed under ORS 291.208 discrete amounts necessary to fund the projected**  
4 **costs of continuing state support for the following currently authorized programs and ac-**  
5 **tivities for the next biennium:**

6 **“(a) Children’s advocacy centers as defined in ORS 418.782;**

7 **“(b) The Survivor Housing Funds grant program, or any successor program that provides**  
8 **funds to assist victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, dating violence and**  
9 **human trafficking to access and maintain safe permanent housing; and**

10 **“(c) The Oregon Domestic and Sexual Violence Services Fund established under ORS**  
11 **147.453.**

12 **“(2) When calculating the amounts described in subsection (1) of this section, the de-**  
13 **partment may include in the total up to 10 percent for department administrative costs.**

14 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2024 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 418.746 to**  
15 **418.796.**

16 **“SECTION 3. (1) The director of a children’s advocacy center shall submit to the De-**  
17 **partment of Justice, by no later than April 1 of each even-numbered year, projected costs**  
18 **of the center for the next biennium, along with estimates for all sources of funding other**  
19 **than the state, including but not limited to insurance reimbursements, court witness fees,**  
20 **private donations and governmental grants.**

21 **“(2) Each director of a children’s advocacy center submitting information under sub-**  
22 **section (1) of this section shall certify that the submitted information is true and correct**  
23 **and that the accuracy of all numerical information has been verified.**

24 **“SECTION 4. Section 1 of this 2024 Act applies to biennia beginning on or after July 1,**  
25 **2025.**

26 **“SECTION 5. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
27 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect**  
28 **on its passage.”.**
