3	"SECTION 3. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall convene a work group
4	of relevant stakeholders to provide recommendations on a voluntary Columbia River gillnet
5	vessel permit buyback program.
6	"(2) The work group shall consist of at least six members selected by the State Fish and
7	Wildlife Director, including but not limited to:
8	"(a) Two members representing Columbia River gillnet vessel permit holders;
9	"(b) One member representing Oregon seafood processors;
10	"(c) One member representing Columbia River recreational fishing businesses;
11	"(d) One member representing a nonprofit organization comprised of Columbia River
12	recreational anglers; and
13	"(e) One member representing a nonprofit organization focused on the conservation of
14	Columbia River salmonid populations.
15	"(3) The work group shall:
16	"(a) Consider how a voluntary Columbia River gillnet vessel permit buyback program in
17	Oregon can best complement the Columbia River gillnet fishing license reduction program
18	implemented by the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife; and
19	"(b) Make recommendations on:
20	"(A) The specifics of a voluntary Columbia River gillnet vessel permit buyback program;
21	and
22	"(B) Any changes to laws, rules or funding levels that would be needed in order to im-
23	plement the program.
24	"(4) All recommendations described in subsection (3) of this section must be consistent
25	with tribal treaty fishing rights and all fishery management agreements between Indian
26	tribes and this state.
27	"(5) The department shall report on the recommendations described in subsection (3) of
28	this section, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the committees or interim
29	committees of the Legislative Assembly related to natural resources, in the manner provided
30	under ORS 192.245, no later than November 15, 2024.
31	"SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2024 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.".
