15 “SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
16 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (7), chapter 610, Oregon Laws  
17 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for intellectual/developmental disabilities pro-  
18 grams, is increased by \$78,216 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this 2024  
19 Act and the amendments to ORS 427.181 and 443.889 and section 2, chapter 568, Oregon Laws  
20 2023, by sections 3, 4 and 7 of this 2024 Act.

21 “SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
22 expenditures established by section 3 (7), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium  
23 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds,  
24 excluding federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected  
25 or received by the Department of Human Services, for intellectual/developmental disabilities  
26 programs, is increased by \$78,216 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this  
27 2024 Act and the amendments to ORS 427.181 and 443.889 and section 2, chapter 568, Oregon  
28 Laws 2023, by sections 3, 4 and 7 of this 2024 Act.

29 “SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
30 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (2), chapter 610, Oregon Laws  
31 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs,  
32 is increased by \$8,331 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this 2024 Act and  
33 the amendments to ORS 427.181 and 443.889 and section 2, chapter 568, Oregon Laws 2023,  
34 by sections 3, 4 and 7 of this 2024 Act.

35 “SECTION 13. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on

2 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds,  
3 excluding federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected  
4 or received by the Department of Human Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide  
5 costs, is increased by \$8,331 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this 2024  
6 Act and the amendments to ORS 427.181 and 443.889 and section 2, chapter 568, Oregon Laws  
7 2023, by sections 3, 4 and 7 of this 2024 Act.

8 “SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
9 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (1), chapter 610, Oregon Laws  
10 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for central services, is increased by \$888 for  
11 carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this 2024 Act and the amendments to ORS  
12 427.181 and 443.889 and section 2, chapter 568, Oregon Laws 2023, by sections 3, 4 and 7 of this  
13 2024 Act.

14 “SECTION 15. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
15 expenditures established by section 3 (1), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium  
16 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds,  
17 excluding federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected  
18 or received by the Department of Human Services, for central services, is increased by \$888  
19 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this 2024 Act and the amendments to  
20 ORS 427.181 and 443.889 and section 2, chapter 568, Oregon Laws 2023, by sections 3, 4 and 7  
21 of this 2024 Act.

22 “SECTION 16. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
23 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (1), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,  
24 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for Health Systems Division - Administration, is in-  
25 creased by \$62,208, for carrying out the provisions of section 6 of this 2024 Act.

26 “SECTION 17. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
27 expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium  
28 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,  
29 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or  
30 received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Health Services Division - Administration, is  
31 increased by \$62,208, for carrying out the provisions of section 6 of this 2024 Act.

32 “SECTION 18. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
33 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,  
34 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is  
35 increased by \$3,516, for carrying out the provisions of section 6 of this 2024 Act.

36 “SECTION 19. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
37 expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium  
38 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,  
39 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or  
40 received by the Oregon Health Authority, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs,  
41 is increased by \$3,516, for carrying out the provisions of section 6 of this 2024 Act.”.
