SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act requires ODOT to study a section of U.S. Highway 30. ODOT must make a report of the study and share its findings with the JCT. ODOT may start work on the study 91 days after sine die. (Flesch Readability Score: 69.9).

Requires the Department of Transportation to conduct a review of a specific portion of U.S. Highway 30 and present a report to the Joint Committee on Transportation no later than September 15, 2025.

Sunset on January 2, 2026.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to U.S. Highway 30; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of U.S. Highway**
5 **30 and shall make a report on the department's findings.**

6 **(2) The report must include:**

7 **(a) An assessment of the condition of U.S. Highway 30, beginning at milepost 49 and**
8 **ending at milepost 94;**

9 **(b) Information regarding deficiencies in the condition of U.S. Highway 30, beginning at**
10 **milepost 49 and ending at milepost 94;**

11 **(c) Recommendations for improving the condition of U.S. Highway 30, beginning at**
12 **milepost 49 and ending at milepost 94, to a state of good repair;**

13 **(d) A cost estimate for the recommended improvements; and**

14 **(e) Any other information that the department deems pertinent and useful to share with**
15 **the Joint Committee on Transportation.**

16 **(3) The department shall submit the report required by this section, and may include**
17 **recommendations for legislation, to the Joint Committee on Transportation in the manner**
18 **provided under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2025.**

19 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2024 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.**

20 **SECTION 3. This 2024 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2024**
21 **regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
