

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1578

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 15, after “access” insert “for Oregon Health Plan
2 members”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 7 through 11 and insert:

4 “(a) Provide an online scheduling mechanism that health care providers, including coordinated
5 care organizations, may use to directly schedule appointments with certified and qualified health
6 care interpreters for purposes of serving Oregon Health Plan members; and

7 “(b) Process billing and payments for health care interpreter services that were rendered to
8 Oregon Health Plan members and scheduled through the interpreter management system.”.

9 In line 39, after “to” delete the rest of the line and delete line 40 and insert “Oregon Health
10 Plan members.” and begin a new paragraph and insert:

11 “**SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
12 **made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (1), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the**
13 **biennium ending June 30, 2025, for Health Systems Division - Administration, is increased**
14 **by \$280,274, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.**

15 “**SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
16 **expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium**
17 **ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,**
18 **excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or**
19 **received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Health Services Division - Administration, is**
20 **increased by \$280,274, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.**

21 “**SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
22 **made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (6), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the**
23 **biennium ending June 30, 2025, for central services, is increased by \$260,000, for carrying out**
24 **the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.**

25 “**SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
26 **expenditures established by section 5 (6), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium**
27 **ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,**
28 **excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or**
29 **received by the Oregon Health Authority, for central services, is increased by \$240,000, for**
30 **carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.**

31 “**SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation**
32 **made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the**
33 **biennium ending June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased**
34 **by \$6,856, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.**

35 “**SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**

1 expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
2 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
3 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or
4 received by the Oregon Health Authority, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs,
5 is increased by \$6,856, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024 Act.

6 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
7 expenditures established by section 2 (10), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
8 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
9 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts, marijuana tax re-
10 cepts, beer and wine tax receipts, provider taxes and Medicare receipts, but excluding lot-
11 tery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
12 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for shared administrative services, is
13 increased by \$302,148, for carrying out the provisions of sections 2, 3 and 4 of this 2024
14 Act.”.

15 In line 41, delete “5” and insert “12”.
