

Senate Bill 5702

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act approves certain fees charged by state agencies. (Flesch Readability Score: 75.5).

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by state agencies.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

(1) Private Security Entity License Fee: \$624

(2) Late Renewal Fee: \$50

(3) Duplicate or Replacement License Fee: \$24

(4) Non-sufficient Funds Penalty Fee: \$25

SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), a fingerprinting and background check fee of \$140, adopted by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, is approved.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Agriculture and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

(1) Hemp Grower Late Fee: \$250

(2) Noncommercial Pesticide Applicator License per year, including one category: \$50

(3) Noncommercial Pesticide Applicator License per year, for each additional category: \$7.50

(4) Noncommercial Pesticide Applicator License per year, for each additional category after license issued: \$12.50

(5) Noncommercial Pesticide Trainee License: \$50

SECTION 4. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Department of Environmental Quality and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

(1) Seismic Risk Assessment Submittal Fee: \$39,000

(2) Annual Compliance Fee: \$23,000

(3) Risk Mitigation Implementation Plan Submittal Fee: \$36,000

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 (4) Mattress Stewardship Fee: \$205,000

2 (5) Carrier Permit Annual Compliance: \$200

3 **SECTION 5.** For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), an Al-
4cohol Delivery Training Program Review Fee of \$250, adopted by the Oregon Liquor and
5Cannabis Commission and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services,
6is approved.

7 **SECTION 6.** This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
8peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect
9on its passage.
