

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 204

1 On page 1 of the printed concurrent resolution, after line 9, insert:

2 “Whereas in 1981, during his first session as a member of the House of Representatives, Bill
3 Bradbury sponsored and worked to pass legislation creating the Salmon and Trout Enhancement
4 Program, empowering Oregonians to contribute to the recovery and sustainability of Oregon’s pop-
5 ulation of native salmon and trout; and

6 “Whereas in 1983, Bill Bradbury worked with the Oregon Community College Association to
7 pass legislation creating Small Business Development Centers at community colleges throughout
8 Oregon, giving entrepreneurs in Oregon their best shot at success; and

9 “Whereas more than 40 years later, the programs created by these two crucial pieces of legis-
10 lation are still enriching the lives of Oregonians today; and”.
