**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4051**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 10 through 12 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) No person may wager money or any other thing**
3 **of value on the outcome of a greyhound race or other dog race.**

4 **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a Multi-Jurisdictional**
5 **Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering Totalizator Hub licensed under**
6 **ORS 462.725 from accepting or facilitating mutuel wagers on**
7 **greyhound races from persons outside this state, subject to ORS**
8 **462.725 (7).”.**

9 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 18 and insert:

10 **“(7) A Multi-Jurisdictional Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering**
11 **Totalizator Hub licensee may not facilitate wagering on greyhound racing**
12 **for an individual if either of the following are unlawful in the jurisdiction**
13 **of the individual’s principal residence:**

14 (a) Greyhound racing that is physically occurring within the jurisdiction;
15 or

16 (b) Wagering on greyhound racing described in paragraph (a) of this
17 subsection.”.

18 On page 13, delete lines 8 through 28 and insert:

19 **“SECTION 22. (1) In addition to any other liability or penalty pro-**
20 **vided by law, the Oregon Racing Commission may impose a civil pen-**
21 **alty on a person for any of the following:**

1 **“(a) Violation of ORS 462.020 (1).**

2 **“(b) Accepting or facilitating wagers on animal racing, if the person**
3 **is not authorized to do so under this chapter.**

4 **“(2) A civil penalty under this section may not exceed \$5,000 per**
5 **violation.**

6 **“(3) The commission may adopt rules establishing the civil penalties**
7 **that may be imposed under this section.**

8 **“(4) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed in the man-**
9 **ner provided by ORS 183.745.**

10 **“(5) A civil penalty imposed under this section may be remitted or**
11 **reduced upon such terms and conditions as the commission considers**
12 **proper and consistent with the public good.**

13 **“(6) In imposing a civil penalty pursuant to this section, the com-**
14 **mission shall consider at least the following factors:**

15 **“(a) The past history of the person incurring a penalty in taking**
16 **all feasible steps or procedures necessary or appropriate to correct any**
17 **violation;**

18 **“(b) Any prior violations of statute, rules or orders;**

19 **“(c) The economic and financial conditions of the person incurring**
20 **the penalty; and**

21 **“(d) The immediacy and extent to which the violation threatens the**
22 **public good.**

23 **“(7) All civil penalties recovered under this section shall be depos-**
24 **ited in the General Fund to the credit of the Oregon Racing Commis-**
25 **sion Account established under ORS 462.260.”.**
