**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4051**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 10 through 12 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) No person may wager money or any other thing**
3 **of value on the outcome of a greyhound race or other dog race.**

4 **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a Multi-Jurisdictional**
5 **Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering Totalizator Hub licensed under**
6 **ORS 462.725 from accepting or facilitating mutuel wagers on**
7 **greyhound races, except as provided in ORS 462.725 (7).”.**

8 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 18 and insert:

9 **“(7) A Multi-Jurisdictional Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering**
10 **Totalizator Hub licensee may not facilitate wagering on greyhound racing**
11 **for an individual whose principal residence is in Oregon.”.**

12 On page 13, delete lines 8 through 28 and insert:

13 **“SECTION 22. (1) In addition to any other liability or penalty pro-**
14 **vided by law, the Oregon Racing Commission may impose a civil pen-**
15 **alty on a person for any of the following:**

16 **“(a) Violation of ORS 462.020 (1).**

17 **“(b) Accepting or facilitating wagers on animal racing, if the person**
18 **is not authorized to do so under this chapter.**

19 **“(2) A civil penalty under this section may not exceed \$5,000 per**
20 **violation.**

21 **“(3) The commission may adopt rules establishing the civil penalties**

1 that may be imposed under this section.

2 “(4) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed in the man-
3 ner provided by ORS 183.745.

4 “(5) A civil penalty imposed under this section may be remitted or
5 reduced upon such terms and conditions as the commission considers
6 proper and consistent with the public good.

7 “(6) In imposing a civil penalty pursuant to this section, the com-
8 mission shall consider at least the following factors:

9 “(a) The past history of the person incurring a penalty in taking
10 all feasible steps or procedures necessary or appropriate to correct any
11 violation;

12 “(b) Any prior violations of statute, rules or orders;

13 “(c) The economic and financial conditions of the person incurring
14 the penalty; and

15 “(d) The immediacy and extent to which the violation threatens the
16 public good.

17 “(7) All civil penalties recovered under this section shall be depos-
18 ited in the General Fund to the credit of the Oregon Racing Commis-
19 sion Account established under ORS 462.260.”.
