PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4051

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 10 through 12 and insert:
- "SECTION 2. (1) No person may wager money or any other thing
- 3 of value on the outcome of a greyhound race or other dog race.
- 4 "(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a Multi-Jurisdictional
- 5 Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering Totalizator Hub licensed under
- 6 ORS 462.725 from accepting or facilitating mutuel wagers on
- 7 greyhound races, except as provided in ORS 462.725 (7).".
- 8 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 18 and insert:
- 9 "(7) A Multi-Jurisdictional Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering
- 10 Totalizator Hub licensee may not facilitate wagering on greyhound racing
- 11 for an individual whose principal residence is in Oregon.".
- On page 13, delete lines 8 through 28 and insert:
- "SECTION 22. (1) In addition to any other liability or penalty pro-
- 14 vided by law, the Oregon Racing Commission may impose a civil pen-
- 15 alty on a person for any of the following:
- 16 "(a) Violation of ORS 462.020 (1).

- "(b) Accepting or facilitating wagers on animal racing, if the person is not authorized to do so under this chapter.
- 19 "(2) A civil penalty under this section may not exceed \$5,000 per violation.
 - "(3) The commission may adopt rules establishing the civil penalties

- 1 that may be imposed under this section.
- "(4) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed in the manner provided by ORS 183.745.
- "(5) A civil penalty imposed under this section may be remitted or reduced upon such terms and conditions as the commission considers proper and consistent with the public good.
- "(6) In imposing a civil penalty pursuant to this section, the commission shall consider at least the following factors:
- "(a) The past history of the person incurring a penalty in taking all feasible steps or procedures necessary or appropriate to correct any violation;
 - "(b) Any prior violations of statute, rules or orders;
- 13 "(c) The economic and financial conditions of the person incurring 14 the penalty; and
- 15 "(d) The immediacy and extent to which the violation threatens the 16 public good.
 - "(7) All civil penalties recovered under this section shall be deposited in the General Fund to the credit of the Oregon Racing Commission Account established under ORS 462.260.".
