

Requested by Representative WALTERS

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4098**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert “creating
2 new provisions; amending section 6, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. CHIPS Child Care Work Group. (1) The Oregon Busi-
5 ness Development Department shall establish the CHIPS Child Care
6 Work Group to develop recommendations:**

7 **“(a) To require financial contributions to the CHIPS Child Care
8 Fund established under section 3 of this 2024 Act by businesses that
9 receive a program grant or loan under section 3, chapter 25, Oregon
10 Laws 2023, and federal semiconductor financial assistance, as defined
11 in section 1, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023.**

12 **“(b) To determine the monetary amount of financial contributions
13 and the mechanism by which those contributions are to be made under
14 paragraph (a) of this subsection.**

15 **“(2) The work group must include, at a minimum, representation
16 of relevant state agencies, businesses described in subsection (1) of this
17 section and child care advocates.**

18 **“SECTION 2. Financial support for construction workforce. (1) The
19 Oregon Business Development Department shall enter into an intera-
20 gency agreement with the Bureau of Labor and Industries to develop
21 and administer a program to provide financial support and child care**

1 **subsidies to:**

2 **“(a) Apprentices who are participating in a course of study in con-**
3 **struction under ORS 660.002 to 660.210.**

4 **“(b) Journeyworkers who have completed an apprenticeship in**
5 **construction under ORS 660.002 to 660.210 within the last five years.**

6 **“(2) Financial support under subsection (1) of this section may be**
7 **provided to the apprentice or journeyworker or to the child care pro-**
8 **vider that is providing child care services for the apprentice or**
9 **journeyworker.**

10 **“(3)(a) The department shall adopt rules necessary to administer**
11 **this section.**

12 **“(b) The bureau may adopt rules to carry out this section.**

13 **“(4) The bureau shall evaluate the impact of this section on in-**
14 **creasing diversity in the construction workforce.**

15 **“SECTION 3. CHIPS Child Care Fund. (1) The CHIPS Child Care**
16 **Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from**
17 **the General Fund. Interest earned by the CHIPS Child Care Fund shall**
18 **be credited to the fund.**

19 **“(2) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the**
20 **Oregon Business Development Department for the following purposes:**

21 **“(a) Paying the actual costs incurred by the department to develop**
22 **and administer this section and sections 1, 2 and 4 of this 2024 Act; and**

23 **“(b) Carrying out this section and sections 1, 2 and 4 of this 2024**
24 **Act, including transferring moneys to the Bureau of Labor and In-**
25 **dustries to develop and administer the program described in section 2**
26 **of this 2024 Act.**

27 **“(3) The Oregon Business Development Department may transfer**
28 **moneys deposited in the fund to the Child Care Infrastructure Fund**
29 **established under ORS 329A.725. Moneys transferred under this sub-**
30 **section shall be used by the department to provide financial assistance**

1 under ORS 329A.727 for the purposes of increasing child care
2 infrastructure in geographic areas in this state where semiconductor
3 or other advanced manufacturing facilities are presently located or
4 scheduled to be constructed under sections 1 to 6, chapter 25, Oregon
5 Laws 2023.

6 “(4) The Oregon Business Development Department shall adminis-
7 ter the CHIPS Child Care Fund in consultation with the Bureau of
8 Labor and Industries.

9 “(5) The fund shall consist of moneys credited to the fund, includ-
10 ing:

11 “(a) Moneys appropriated to the fund by the Legislative Assembly;

12 “(b) Moneys transferred to the fund by the Oregon Business Devel-
13 opment Department;

14 “(c) Moneys transferred from the Oregon CHIPS Fund established
15 in section 6, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023;

16 “(d) Moneys contributed to the CHIPS Child Care Fund by busi-
17 nesses that receive a program grant or loan under section 3, chapter
18 25, Oregon Laws 2023, and federal semiconductor financial assistance,
19 as defined in section 1, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023;

20 “(e) Earnings on moneys in the fund;

21 “(f) Moneys received from the federal or state government; and

22 “(g) Moneys from any other public or private source.

23 “**SECTION 3a.** Section 3 of this 2024 Act is amended to read:

24 “**Sec. 3.** (1) The CHIPS Child Care Fund is established in the State
25 Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by
26 the CHIPS Child Care Fund shall be credited to the fund.

27 “(2) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon
28 Business Development Department for the following purposes:

29 “(a) Paying the actual costs incurred by the department to develop and
30 administer this section and [sections 1, 2 and 4] **section 2** of this 2024 Act;

1 and

2 “(b) Carrying out this section and [sections 1, 2 and 4] **section 2** of this
3 2024 Act, including transferring moneys to the Bureau of Labor and Indus-
4 tries to develop and administer the program described in section 2 of this
5 2024 Act.

6 “(3) The Oregon Business Development Department may transfer moneys
7 deposited in the fund to the Child Care Infrastructure Fund established un-
8 der ORS 329A.725. Moneys transferred under this subsection shall be used
9 by the department to provide financial assistance under ORS 329A.727 [*for*
10 *the purposes of increasing child care infrastructure in geographic areas in this*
11 *state where semiconductor or other advanced manufacturing facilities are*
12 *presently located or scheduled to be constructed under sections 1 to 6, chapter*
13 *25, Oregon Laws 2023*].

14 “(4) The Oregon Business Development Department shall administer the
15 CHIPS Child Care Fund in consultation with the Bureau of Labor and In-
16 dustries.

17 “(5) The fund shall consist of moneys credited to the fund, including:

18 “(a) Moneys appropriated to the fund by the Legislative Assembly;

19 “(b) Moneys transferred to the fund by the Oregon Business Development
20 Department;

21 “[*(c) Moneys transferred from the Oregon CHIPS Fund established in sec-*
22 *tion 6, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023;*]

23 “[*(d)*] (c) Moneys contributed to the [*CHIPS Child Care*] fund by busi-
24 nesses that receive a program grant or loan under section 3, chapter 25,
25 Oregon Laws 2023, and federal semiconductor financial assistance, as defined
26 in section 1, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023;

27 “[*(e)*] (d) Earnings on moneys in the fund;

28 “[*(f)*] (e) Moneys received from the federal or state government; and

29 “[*(g)*] (f) Moneys from any other public or private source.

30 **SECTION 4. Report. On or before November 15, 2024, the CHIPS**

1 **Child Care Work Group established in section 1 of this 2024 Act shall**
2 **submit a report, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, on the rec-**
3 **ommendations required by section 1 of this 2024 Act, to the commit-**
4 **tees of the Legislative Assembly related to child care and workforce**
5 **development.**

6 **“SECTION 5.** Section 6, chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to
7 read:

8 **“Sec. 6.** (1) The Oregon CHIPS Fund is established in the State Treasury,
9 separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Oregon
10 CHIPS Fund shall be credited to the fund.

11 **“(2)** Moneys in the fund shall consist of:

12 **“(a)** Amounts appropriated or otherwise transferred or credited to the
13 fund by the Legislative Assembly;

14 **“(b)** Earnings received on moneys in the fund; and

15 **“(c)** Other moneys, or proceeds of property, from any public or private
16 source that are transferred, donated or otherwise credited to the fund.

17 **“(3)** Moneys in the Oregon CHIPS Fund are continuously appropriated to
18 the Oregon Business Development Department for the following purposes:

19 **“(a)** Paying the actual costs incurred by the department in developing and
20 administering sections 1 to 6, **chapter 25, Oregon Laws 2023** [*of this 2023*
21 *Act*]; [*and*]

22 **“(b)** Carrying out the provisions of sections 1 to 6, **chapter 25, Oregon**
23 **Laws 2023** [*of this 2023 Act*]; **and**

24 **“(c)** **Transferring moneys to the CHIPS Child Care Fund established**
25 **under section 3 of this 2024 Act for purpose of carrying out section 2**
26 **of this 2024 Act.**

27 **“(4)** Moneys in the Oregon CHIPS Fund on June 30, 2023, shall be re-
28 tained in the fund, and used for the purposes set forth in subsection (3) of
29 this section, until June 30, 2025.

30 **“(5)** Any moneys remaining in the Oregon CHIPS Fund on June 30, 2025,

1 shall be transferred to the General Fund.

2 **“SECTION 6. Appropriation. In addition to and not in lieu of any**
3 **other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business De-**
4 **velopment Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, out of**
5 **the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, to be deposited into the**
6 **CHIPS Child Care Fund established under section 3 of this 2024 Act.**

7 **“SECTION 7. Operative date. The amendments to section 3 of this**
8 **2024 Act by section 3a of this 2024 Act become operative on January**
9 **1, 2033.**

10 **“SECTION 8. Sunset. Sections 1 and 4 of this 2024 Act are repealed**
11 **on January 2, 2025.**

12 **“SECTION 9. Captions disclaimer. The section captions used in this**
13 **2024 Act are provided only for the convenience of the reader and do**
14 **not become part of the statutory law of this state or express any leg-**
15 **islative intent in the enactment of this 2024 Act.**

16 **“SECTION 10. Effective date. This 2024 Act being necessary for the**
17 **immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an**
18 **emergency is declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect on its**
19 **passage.”.**

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
