**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 4051**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 10 through 12 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) No person may wager money or any other thing**  
3 **of value on the outcome of a greyhound race or other dog race.**

4 **“(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a Multi-Jurisdictional**  
5 **Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering Totalizator Hub licensed under**  
6 **ORS 462.725 from accepting or facilitating mutuel wagers on**  
7 **greyhound races, except as provided in ORS 462.725 (7).”.**

8 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 18 and insert:

9 **“(7) A Multi-Jurisdictional Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering**  
10 **Totalizator Hub licensee may not facilitate wagering on greyhound racing**  
11 **for an individual whose principal residence is in a jurisdiction in which**  
12 **wagering on dog racing is unlawful.”.**

13 On page 12, delete lines 32 through 45.

14 On page 13, delete lines 1 through 3.

15 Delete lines 7 through 28 and insert:

16 **“SECTION 19. Section 20 of this 2024 Act is added to and made a**  
17 **part of ORS chapter 462.**

18 **“SECTION 20. (1) In addition to any other liability or penalty pro-**  
19 **vided by law, the Oregon Racing Commission may impose a civil pen-**  
20 **alty on a person for any of the following:**

21 **“(a) Violation of ORS 462.020 (1).**

1       **“(b) Accepting or facilitating wagers on animal racing, if the person**  
2 **is not authorized to do so under this chapter.**

3       **“(2) The commission may adopt rules establishing the civil penalties**  
4 **that may be imposed under this section.**

5       **“(3) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed in the man-**  
6 **ner provided by ORS 183.745.**

7       **“(4) A civil penalty imposed under this section may be remitted or**  
8 **reduced upon such terms and conditions as the commission considers**  
9 **proper and consistent with the public good.**

10       **“(5) In imposing a civil penalty pursuant to this section, the com-**  
11 **mission shall consider at least the following factors:**

12       **“(a) The past history of the person incurring a penalty in taking**  
13 **all feasible steps or procedures necessary or appropriate to correct any**  
14 **violation;**

15       **“(b) Any prior violations of statute, rules or orders;**

16       **“(c) The economic and financial conditions of the person incurring**  
17 **the penalty; and**

18       **“(d) The immediacy and extent to which the violation threatens the**  
19 **public good.**

20       **“(6) All civil penalties recovered under this section shall be depos-**  
21 **ited in the General Fund to the credit of the Oregon Racing Commis-**  
22 **sion Account established under ORS 462.260.”.**

23       In line 32, delete “23” and insert “21”.

24       In line 38, delete “24” and insert “22”.
