3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 111.055 is amended to read:

"111.055. (1) All probate jurisdiction, authority, powers, functions and
duties of the county courts and the judges thereof are transferred to the
circuit courts and the judges thereof in all counties except Gilliam, Grant,
Harney, Malheur, Sherman and Wheeler Counties.

9 "(2) All probate jurisdiction, authority, powers, functions and duties of 10 the circuit courts and the judges thereof are transferred to the county courts 11 and the judges thereof in Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Sherman and 12 Wheeler Counties.

"(3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) of this section, the
county court of Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Sherman or Wheeler
Counties may approve a transfer of the probate jurisdiction, authority,
powers, functions and duties of the county court to the circuit courts,
and set an effective date of the transfer.

18 **"SECTION 2.** ORS 111.075 is amended to read:

"111.075. (1) Jurisdiction of all probate matters, causes and proceedings is vested in the county courts of Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Sherman and Wheeler Counties and in the circuit court for each other county and as 1 provided in ORS 111.115.

"(2) On the effective date of a transfer of jurisdiction by the county $\mathbf{2}$ court of Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Sherman or Wheeler 3 Counties under ORS 111.055 (3), jurisdiction of all probate matters, 4 causes and proceedings is vested in the circuit court for that county, $\mathbf{5}$ and all matters, causes and proceedings relating to jurisdiction, au-6 thority, powers, functions and duties transferred to the circuit court 7 and pending in the county on the effective date of the transfer, are 8 transferred to the circuit court for the county. 9

"SECTION 3. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect on its passage.".
