 or after October 1, 2024.
- 18 "SECTION 11. Sections 2 and 4 of this 2024 Act are repealed on June 19 30, 2026.
- "SECTION 12. (1) Sections 2 and 4 of this 2024 Act and the amendments to ORS 689.005 and 743A.051 by sections 5 and 7 of this 2024 Act become operative on October 1, 2024.
- "(2) The Oregon Health Authority and the State Board of Pharmacy
 may take any action before the operative date specified in this section
 that is necessary to enable the authority and the board to exercise,
 on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section,
 all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the authority and
 the board by sections 2 and 4 of this 2024 Act and the amendments to
 ORS 689.005 and 743A.051 by sections 5 and 7 of this 2024 Act.
