**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4140**

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) Each biennium, the Department of Justice shall**
3 **include in its agency request budget filed under ORS 291.208 discrete**
4 **amounts necessary to fund the projected costs of continuing state**
5 **support for the following currently authorized programs and activities**
6 **for the next biennium:**

7 **“(a) Children’s advocacy centers as defined in ORS 418.782;**

8 **“(b) The Survivor Housing Funds grant program, or any successor**
9 **program that provides funds to assist victims of domestic violence,**
10 **sexual assault, stalking, dating violence and human trafficking to ac-**
11 **cess and maintain safe permanent housing; and**

12 **“(c) The Oregon Domestic and Sexual Violence Services Fund es-**
13 **tablished under ORS 147.453.**

14 **“(2) When calculating the amounts described in subsection (1) of**
15 **this section, the department may include in the total up to 10 percent**
16 **for department administrative costs.**

17 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2024 Act is added to and made a part**
18 **of ORS 418.746 to 418.796.**

19 **“SECTION 3. (1) The director of a children’s advocacy center shall**
20 **submit to the Department of Justice, by no later than April 1 of each**
21 **even-numbered year, projected costs of the center for the next**

1 biennium, along with estimates for all sources of funding other than
2 the state, including but not limited to insurance reimbursements,
3 court witness fees, private donations and governmental grants.

4 “(2) Each director of a children’s advocacy center submitting in-
5 formation under subsection (1) of this section shall certify that the
6 submitted information is true and correct and that the accuracy of all
7 numerical information has been verified.

8 “SECTION 4. Section 1 of this 2024 Act applies to biennia beginning
9 on or after July 1, 2025.

10 “SECTION 5. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate
11 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
12 declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
