PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4085

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "prescribing an effective
- 2 date" and insert "declaring an emergency".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 6 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'noncitizen' means an individual
- 5 who is not a citizen or national of the United States. "Noncitizen" includes:
- 6 "(a) An individual who is a recipient of the Deferred Action for Childhood
- 7 Arrivals status issued by the United States Citizenship and Immigration
- 8 Services.
- 9 "(b) An individual who otherwise meets the eligibility criteria to receive
- the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals status issued by the United
- 11 States Citizenship and Immigration Services.
- "(c) An individual from Iraq or Afghanistan who was provided with the
- 13 status of special immigrant by the United States Department of Homeland
- 14 Security under:
- "(A) Section 1059(a) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
- 16 Year 2006, P.L. 109-163, 119 Stat. 3443-3444;
- "(B) Section 1244(b) of the Refugee Crisis in Iraq Act of 2007, P.L. 110-181,
- 18 122 Stat. 397; or
- "(C) Section 602(b) of the Afghan Allies Protection Act of 2009, P.L. 111-8,
- 20 123 Stat. 807.
- 21 "(2) The Department of Human Services shall provide grants to assist

- individuals who are noncitizens to change their immigration status or obtain
- 2 lawful permanent resident status.".
- 3 In line 7, delete "(2)(a)" and insert "(3)(a)".
- Delete lines 15 through 21 and insert:
- 5 "(4)(a) An individual who has an adjusted gross income for the prior tax
- 6 year that is not greater than 200 percent of the federal poverty guidelines
- 7 shall be eligible for a grant under this section in an amount that covers all
- 8 costs and fees described in subsection (3)(a) of this section.
- 9 "(b) An individual who has an adjusted gross income for the prior tax
- 10 year that is greater than 200 percent of the federal poverty guidelines shall
- be eligible for a grant under this section in the following amounts:
- "(A) \$1,500 for an individual who has an adjusted gross income for the
- prior tax year that is not greater than \$60,000.
- 14 "(B) \$1,000 for an individual who has an adjusted gross income for the
- prior tax year that is greater than \$60,000 and not greater than \$70,000.
- 16 "(C) \$750 for an individual who has an adjusted gross income for the prior
- tax year that is greater than \$70,000 and not greater than \$80,000.
- "(5) Notwithstanding subsection (4) of this section, the department may
- 19 provide a grant recipient additional financial assistance to cover the costs
- 20 and fees for obtaining a lawful permanent resident status that are not cov-
- 21 ered by the grant moneys awarded under this section to the grant
- 22 recipient.".
- 23 In line 22, delete "(4)" and insert "(6)".
- In line 24, delete "(5)" and insert "(7)".
- In line 27, delete "(6)" and insert "(8)".
- On page 2, delete lines 4 and 5 and insert:
- "SECTION 3. This 2024 Act being necessary for the immediate
- 28 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
- declared to exist, and this 2024 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
