PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4002

Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 101.090, 408.380, 430.021, 430.315, 442.015 and 442.315, for the period beginning January 1, 2025, and ending December 31, 2029, a new hospital is not subject to the requirements of ORS 442.315 to obtain a certificate of need from the Oregon Health Authority if the hospital provides substance use disorder treatment, including alcohol withdrawal services, as its primary focus.

"(2) A new hospital opened or a hospital that added new services or bed types without obtaining a certificate of need pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall obtain a certificate of need for any additional beds, changes in designations of beds, new facilities or changes to the type of facility that will be commenced on or after January 1, 2030, if the changes or additions were not reflected in the initial applications or applications for renewals of licensure approved during the period described in subsection (1) of this section."
