Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 2 the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter 457, 3 Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-4 imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve- $\mathbf{5}$ nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds 6 and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Employees Re-7 tirement System, for the Central Administration Division, is increased 8 by \$316,153, for the implementation of the amendments to ORS 238.005 9 and 238A.160 by sections 1 and 4 of this 2024 Act. 10

"SECTION 20. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 11 12the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (3), chapter 457, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the max-13 imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-14 nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds 15and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Employees Re-16 tirement System, for the Information Services Division, is increased 17 by \$540,624, for the implementation of the amendments to ORS 238.005 18 and 238A.160 by sections 1 and 4 of this 2024 Act. 19

"SECTION 21. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (4), chapter 457,

Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Employees Retirement System, for the Operations Division, is increased by \$1,180,755, for the implementation of the amendments to ORS 238.005 and 238A.160 by sections 1 and 4 of this 2024 Act.".
