As programs and needs have grown, funding has not followed. In fact, it has been greatly reduced. This inability to sustain and build programs has not only been detrimental to children, but has had negative impacts on our parents, employers and economic community as a whole. Lack of funding for summer programming, in communities already identified as "Childcare Deserts" has resulted in parents leaving the work force to stay home with their children. This has exacerbated the staffing shortages already deeply felt by employers. Unfortunately, this problem is not new, just continuing to grow.
