First, instead of doing another study, review studies already done by OHA and other states. Second, put in place easy to implement restrictions on gun ownership by those with a history of mental or behavioral issues as well as those with a criminal history involving firearms. This should be a reporting mechanism for physicians and other health professionals as well as gun shop owners and gun shows. It should NOT be placed on the backs of sheriff departments and police departments to implement. They have enough to do.

Lastly, gun ownership, for those deemed eligible, is a right which should only be abridged when an individual falls into one of the categories stated above.
