Dear Co-Chair Gorsek, Co-Chair McLain, Vice-Chair Boquist, and Vice-Chair Boshart Davis:

I'm writing on behalf of the Salem City Council in support of SB 1572, which would study a commuter rail extension of TriMet's Westside Express Service commuter line to Salem. The possible extension provides a reliable car-free option for the Willamette Valley and an alternative to traveling by car on I-5, reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

Salem's City Council supports the extension of TriMet's Westside Express Service commuter line to Salem with a unanimous vote of support at our January 23, 2023 meeting. The City of Salem is taking action to respond to climate change with a Climate Action Plan that outlines strategies and actions to reduce Greenhouse Gas emissions and increase climate resiliency in our community. This long-standing goal, adopted by City Council in October of 2020, can only be achieved with the collective action of everyone in our community. By offering other choices, like the Westside Express Service commuter line extension to Salem, we'll be closer to our goals of reduce Salem's GHG emissions by 50% by 2035 and making Salem is a carbon neutral city by 2050.
